Fyfe Park, Kemnay Flooding Issues - Councillor Payne

Dear Councillor Payne

I refer to your correspondence in which you asked about flooding issues at Fyfe Park, Kemnay.

Firstly we apologise for the time it has taken to respond to your query. We had to consult with multiple teams and the winter break combined with staffing issues meant that we were unable to provide a response in our usual timeframe.

The local team sent out an inspector to investigate these issues and determined that the flooding issues here were most likely coming from the nearby field's surface water upon heavy rain falling in this area. As such the team is looking to issue a RSA Section 99 notice (Road Scotland Act 1984) to the owner of these fields to ensure that proper drainage can be installed and prevent further flooding from occurring on the road here. We will ask the local team to issue this RSA Notice though we note this process may take a while to complete.
